

I was diagnosed with a brain tumor at 10 months of age and underwent surgery for removal in May 1978. This was after doctors in Baltimore and Duke found nothing. Seizures followed until the age of 15. But, it was at that age I found Jesus and found the motivation to continue to thrive. By the time I was 17 I was off all meds and I have not had a seizure since August of 1992.

My wife and I began a mission in 2014 in honor and in memory of those with brain tumors. Since then, we have traveled to cancer hospitals all over the country and have given to outreaches throughout the United States and 15 other countries, totaling nearly 21,000 Bibles.
